<u>Curriculum and Topics</u>

This half term we will be working on a 'Buildings & Farms' topic and will cover the following areas:-

- **Science**—The seasons and our weather.
- Computing—Programming a moving robot. "A B C searching" and "Keywords"- using the internet to collect information.
- Geography Seasonal and daily weather patterns.
- **History** Local farming in the past.
- DT- Y1/2 -studying and exploring structures for stability. Designing and making a house.

Reception— cutting and sticking skills, printing, collage and malleable materials

• Music— Y1/2 songs related to buildings/structures, the concept of pitch and simple composition.

Reception—high and low sounds, singing nursery rhymes.

- PE— gymnastic skills.
- Dance—"Three little pigs."
- PSHE— Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco awareness, Being a risk taker, Home safety.
- RE— Y1/2 -"Jesus was special" and Reception "Special people"

**Literacy**— Reception and Y1/2—Traditional Tales - re-telling and writing their own versions of stories such as "The three little pigs."

Y1/2—Poems with a structure—eg. riddles

Comprehension skills will be developed.

Handwriting, spellings and phonic work will continue as normal, based on the phonics being studied in class.

Y1/2 -Please can spelling books be returned to school on Mondays ready for the weekly spelling test. Thank you

Numeracy— Number topics to be studied this half term include:- Y1/2 addition and subtraction

Multiplication, doubling, counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

Topic maths will include work on length.

**Reception** -Introducing zero, comparison and comparing to 5, composition of numbers to 5 and comparing mass & capacity.

Please can Y1/2 Maths homework folders be returned to school on Wednesdays ready for the next task to be sent home. PE bags and water bottles also need returning to school asap.
