<p>In Science in year 3 and 4 we will be looking at the importance of light and noticing how it is reflected. We will also look at how shadows are formed. In year 5 and 6 we will be looking at how light travels and how shadows are formed.</p> <p>In History, we will be learning about the Vikings and the struggle for the kingdom of England up to the time of Edward the Confessor. Our enquiry question is: 'What was the impact of the Vikings on Britain?'</p> <p>In RE we will be learning about significant women in the Old Testament. Our enquiry question is 'How did God use the women and how do their stories fit into God's Big Story?'</p> <p>In PE we will be studying Dance with the Vikings as our stimulus.</p> <p>In Art we will be extending our sketching skills, learning to shade and create realistic interpretations of Viking Longships. Our key learning outcome is to use art pencils to create shade.</p> <p>In French we will be learning to read and recite the days of the week, months of the year and numbers to 100. In Spring 2 we will be learning how to talk about the weather.</p> <p>In Computing in year 5 and 6 we will learn how to create a short video, we will develop skills in capturing, editing and manipulating video.</p> <p>In Computing in year 3 and 4 we will learn how to use desktop publishing, knowing the words text and image and how to use them to create a document.
