In DT we will develop our sewing skills by designing and making a soft toy, linked to the creatures of the Amazon Rainforest. We will learn new stitches and how to use applique to decorate. In Computing we will explore the concept of sequencing in programming through Scratch. It begins with an introduction to the programming environment. We will create their own programs, featuring sequences. The final project is to make a representation of a piano. In Y5/6 we will be focussing on real-life projects through construction of programs.			

In MFL we will be focusing on reading, writing, listening and speaking about foods and clothes. Y6 will host a whole school fashion show with a refreshment café.

In PSHE we will be focusing on relationships, describing different types of relationships, explaining what makes a healthy, positive relationship/ friendship and ways to avoid or resolve arguments and other friendship issues. We will discuss the importance of when a secret should not be kept, but told to a trusted adult. We will look at peer pressure and how to deal with it.
