<p>In Science year 3/4 will be learning about forces and magnets, including pushing and pulling. We will be doing investigations and presenting our findings. In Y5/6 we will be learning about the human body, including the human circulatory system.</p> <p>In History we will be learning about the changes from The Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will explore the chronology of Historical periods and find out how people lived, what they ate, wore and how the changes impacted Britain.</p> <p>In Art we will be finding out how Stone Age people used natural materials such as clay to improve their quality of life. We will be using their designs as inspiration for our own clay work, learning to make joins strong and shape materials for aesthetic purposes.</p> <p>In Music we are following the Charanga Scheme and will be learning more about notation. We will ask 'what can music tell us about the past?' and will use glockenspiels to play an ensemble tune and improvise our own melodies.</p> <p>In RE, our enquiry question is 'Is everyone's life journey the same?'. We will explore the journey through life and find out about the life journeys of biblical characters as well as Christians today. We will also learn about the pilgrimages of Christians and those from other religions.</p> <p>In French we will learning about greetings and numbers in Y3/4 and weather and journeys in Y5/6, we will focus on question words, adverbs and conjunctions .</p> <p>In PSHE our focus is self awareness and wellbeing. We will be learning about self esteem and the importance of self care and how to seek help if we feel mentally unwell. We will be naming feelings and exploring how to deal positively with negative emotions.</p> <p>In Computing in Y3/4 we will be learning about the internet. We will explore how a network can share messages with another network to form the internet. They will consider some of the network devices involved in this, such as routers, and then discuss what we should keep in and out of a network to keep safe.</p> <p>In Y5/6 we will be learning about communication and collaboration. We will explore how data is transferred over the internet. Initially focusing on addressing, before they move on to the makeup and structure of data packets. Then looking at how the internet facilitates online communication and collaboration.</p> <p>In PE we will be learning about invasion games. How to defend, attack, and use tactics.
