<p>In Science year3 / 4 will be learning about animals , including humans. We will look at the purpose of our teeth and the different types that we have. We will also look at the digestive system.</p> <p>In Y5/6 we will be learning about Electricity. We will learn the symbols associated with circuits be able to create and recreate simple circuits.</p> <p>In History we will be learning about Ancient Egypt and how life was in ancient times, including the legacy of Ancient Egypt.</p> <p>In Art we will be extending our collage skills including creating Egyptian images from different geometric shapes. We will also explore Ancient Egyptian art, and will design and sculpt the topper of a canopic jar.</p> <p>In Music we will be continuing learning about notation and will be singing and performing in groups as well as preparing for the Young Voices concert.</p> <p>In RE we will be learning about the religion of Judaism. We will find links to Christianity and explore the core beliefs of Jewish people.</p> <p>In French Y3/4 we will learning about numbers and stationery objects.</p> <p>In Y5/6 we will be learning to describe our families.</p> <p>French day will be enriched by our visit from French visitors who we will introduce ourselves to and have French conversations with.</p> <p>In PSHE our focus is living in the wider world and the role of the government. We will also be learning about the rule of law.</p> <p>In Computing in Y3/4 we will be looking at programming. We will be giving children the chance to create algorithms, breaking down tasks into smaller parts (codes) and use skills to create a count-controlled loop.</p> <p>In Y5/6 we will be looking at variables in games.
