<p>In <b>Expressive Arts and Design</b> we will focus on:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Exploring different techniques such as weaving and collage.</li> <li>2. Handling different threads, wools, fabrics and sorting and matching them by colours and textures.</li> <li>3. Cutting fabrics, cards and paper using scissors and sticking with assorted glues and tapes.</li> <li>4. Singing songs on an oceans theme.</li> <li>5. Exploring long and short sounds in the environment and creating long and short sounds.</li> </ol> <p>In <b>Physical Development</b> we will focus on:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Developing the fundamental movement skills of running, jumping, skipping, hopping, throwing and catching.</li> <li>2. Cosmic kids Yoga, with a seaside theme.</li> </ol> <p>In <b>RE</b> we will focus on:- Special times</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Reflecting on our own experiences of special times – weddings, anniversaries, baptisms, birthdays</li> <li>2. Knowing the story of Pentecost.</li> <li>3.
