<p>In Science year3 / 4 will be continuing our work on sound, using data loggers to gather results and investigating how sound travels.</p> <p>In Y5/6 we will be continuing to study living things and their habitats, carrying out research and studying microorganisms.</p> <p>In History we will be learning about World War 2. Our learning will focus on the British response to war and life on the Home Front and how life was for evacuated children.</p> <p>In DT we will be developing our sewing skills linking to our World War 2 topic. We will find out about the 'Make do and Mend' ethos from the 1940s and will create our own new product using old clothes.</p> <p>In Music we will be continuing learning about rhythm and notation. We will use both tuned and non-tuned instruments to create and play rhythms and perform our compositions individually and together.</p> <p>In RE we will studying Christian Art, comparing artists impressions of stories from the Bible, and how Christian artists express their faith through their work.</p> <p>In French we will learning about ordering food and animals in Y3/4.</p> <p>In 5/6 we will be learning to order food and read aloud a story in French.</p> <p>Y6 will be planning activities linked to the text for the whole school's French day.</p> <p>We will all be learning about French culture and famous buildings.</p> <p>In PSHE our focus is RSE. we will be learning about the changes in our bodies as we grow and develop.</p> <p>Y3/4 will focus on how our body ages and some changes (y4 menstruation)</p> <p>In y5/6 we will be learning about puberty, conception and how babies grow and develop</p> <p>In Computing in Y3/4 we will be learning how to edit photos. We will look at the concept of editing images, talk about ethics behind this, learn how to recolour, creating our own edited images and evaluating what we have learnt.</p> <p>In Y5/6 we will be using video editing techniques to create a video and piecing together small parts of videos to create a longer video.</p> <p>In PE we will be focusing on athletics.
