Welcome to EYFS & Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term in we are beginning our **History** theme in which we will explore the question: What happened at the Great Fire of London?



We will be learning about the timeline of events, building up to the Great Fire of London, composing a report of the event and look at similarities and differences between life in different periods.

> In **English** we will be learning about Fairy Tales, Traditional rhymes & Nursery Rhymes. Our core texts are Cinderella, Snow white and a range of rhymes.

We will create own versions of Fairy Tales & Nursery Rhymes.

Maths this half term, will focus on EYFS: Matching, sorting and comparing Measure & Pattern

Y1/2: Place Value within 20.

Addition and subtraction within 20.

In Science, we will be investigating the Uses of Everyday Materials.



We will work scientifically to investigate The Physical Properties of Everyday Materials.

In Computing we will be Grouping Data.

In **PE**, we will be doing: EYFS: nursery rhymes in dance & Fundamental Movement Skills in games.

Y1/2: Assessing fundamental movement skills and Rolling a Ball.

In Music lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat and pulse through assorted songs.

In Art, we will work with assorted paints and drawing materials to develop our painting and drawing skills.
