
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This term in **History** we will explore the question: Scott of the Antarctic

> In **English** we will be exploring stories and poems on a Polar theme, resulting in us creating our own poem and an information booklet about polar




Maths this half term, will focus on EYFS: Number, mass, capacity, length and height

In Computing we will be doing Digital Writing.
