Welcome to EYFS & Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term in **Geography** we will explore the question:
Where in the world is Mexico?



We will discover how Mexico pieces together and will be able to visualise and describe the many varied landscapes, comparing them to where we live.



In **English** we will be exploring Fantasy stories, resulting in us creating our own fantasy stories. We will also be writing non-chronological reports all about Mexico.

Maths this half term, will focus on
EYFS: Number, length, height, time and 3D shape.
Y1: Length, height, mass, volume, multiplication and division.
Y2: Length, height, mass, capacity, temperature, multiplication and division

In **Science**, we will be investigating
Living Things and their Habitats



We will work scientifically to identify and name animals and plants in their habitats

In **Computing** we will be Programming Animations using Scratch Junior.

In **PE**, we will be focusing on:
EYFS: Fundamental Movement Skills in games.
Y1/2: Underarm throwing
Dance based on "Fire, Fire!"
Our PE lessons will take place on:
Monday & Thursday

In **Music** lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat, pulse and recognising different sounds.

In **Art**, we will explore Mexican folk art to investigate colour, line and pattern.

In **RE** this half term our units will be:
EYFS Easter "Why do Christians believe that Easter is all about love?"
Y1/2 - Easter "How do symbols help us to understand the story?"
