Welcome to EYFS & Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term in **History** we will explore the question:
Is the Wright Brothers contribution to flying the most important yet?



We will be learning about the Wright Brothers, Amelia Earhart and Amy Johnson and what impact their legacies have had on the world.

In **English** we will be exploring persuasive texts, resulting in us creating our own leaflet about visiting Leck, as well as stories from other cultures as part of Drawing Club.



Maths this half term will focus on:

EYFS: Numbers to 20, addition and subtraction plus shape.

Y1: Fractions, position and direction plus place value to 100.

Y2: Fractions and time.

In **Science**, we will be investigating Living Things and Their Habitats



We will work scientifically to investigate food chains.

In **Computing** we will be learning how to use and create pictograms

In **PE**, we will be focusing on:

EYFS: Fundamental Movement Skills in games.

Y1&2: Overarm throwing, bouncing and catching. We will also be developing our orienteering skills using our new orienteering course.

Our PE lessons will take place on:

Monday & Thursday

In **Music** lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat, pulse and improvisation.

In **DT**, we will be exploring mechanisms and how to make a wheeled vehicle.



Our **SCARF PSHE** theme this half term is all about "**Keeping myself safe**".

In **RE** this half term our units will be:
EYFS "Special places" - "*What makes a place special/holy?*"

Y1&2 "Why is the church a special place for Christians?". The children will also have opportunities to develop their understanding of special places in world faiths by exploring the question: "*Where do people of other faiths worship?*"
