Welcome to EYFS & Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term in **Geography** we will explore the question:
What is it like to live in Lancaster?



We will be learning about Lancaster, locating its parks and playgrounds. Looking at what shops it has and using maps to represent different places on a map.

In **English** we will be exploring instruction writing, resulting in us creating our own instructions on a plant theme, as well as stories with a plant and wild theme.



Maths this half term will focus on

EYFS: Addition and subtraction, shape plus sharing and grouping.

Y1: Place value within 100, money and time.Y2: Time, statistics, position and direction.

In **Science**, we will be investigating the Plants



We will work scientifically to identify and describe the structure of plants and trees.

In **Computing** we will be learning how to use and create Pictograms

In **PE**, we will be focusing on:

EYFS: Fundamental Movement Skills in games.

Y1&2: Bouncing and catching as well as using our new orienteering course
