Welcome to EYFS and Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term we are beginning our **History** theme in which we will explore the question:
How have toys changed over time?



We will be learning about the timeline of toys throughout history, and looking at similarities and differences between them.

In **English** we will be studying stories set in familiar settings. We will create own versions of these types of text.



Maths this half term, will focus on

EYFS: Matching, sorting and comparing
Measure & Pattern, Representing 1, 2 and 3
Y1: Place Value within 10
Y2: Place value within 100

In **Science**, we will be investigating
Animals including Humans



We will work scientifically to investigate
'How animals change as they get older and what animals need to survive.'

In **Computing** we will be learning about Technology Around Us.

In **daily PE**, we will focus on:

EYFS: nursery rhymes in dance & Fundamental Movement Skills in games.
Y1&2: Assessing fundamental movement skills and Dance based on the story "Once upon a giant." Children will also be swimming on a **Thursday afternoon**.

Please can hair be tied back each day.

In **Music** lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat and pulse through assorted songs.

In **Art**, we will work with assorted paints and drawing materials to develop our painting and drawing skills, whilst working on portraits.

EYFS: "Harvest"
Y1&2: "How can we help those who do not have a good harvest?" and "How do people of Jewish faith celebrate the harvest?"
