Welcome to EYFS & Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term we will continue our **History** theme in which we will explore the question:
How have toys changed over time?



We will be learning about the timeline of toys throughout history, and looking at similarities and differences between them.

In **English** we will be studying stories with repetitive patterns or structures plus recounts of familiar events.

We will create own versions of these types of text.



Maths this half term, will focus on

EYFS: Representing numbers to 5, Composition of 4 & 5, one more and less.
Shapes with 4 sides

Y1: Addition and subtraction to 10 plus 2D and 3D shape.

Y2: Addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers plus 2D/3D shape and lines of symmetry.

In **Science**, we will continue to investigate Animals including Humans



We will work scientifically to investigate, 'How animals change as they get older and what animals need to survive.'

In **daily PE**, we will focus on:

EYFS: "Toys" in dance & Fundamental Movement Skills based on "How to catch star" in games.

Y1/2: Gymnastics, dance based on "Robots."

Children will **NOT** be swimming on a Thursday.
Please can hair be tied back each day.

In **Music** lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat and pulse as well as rehearsing songs for the Christmas play.



In **DT**, we will work with 2D sheet materials to explore card engineering.



Our **SCARF PSHE** theme this half term is all about Rights and Responsibilities

In **RE** this half term our unit will be exploring the following questions linked to Christmas

EYFS: How do Christians celebrate Jesus' birthday?
Y1/2: Why do some people give and receive gifts?



How can I help at home?

EYFS: Keywords, phonics and daily reading.

KS1: Reading daily, number facts flashcards.
