## Curriculum Newsletter Spring 1

Welcome to EYFS & Key Stage One. There will be lots of great learning opportunities to enjoy this half term. We hope you find this newsletter informative. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teachers.

This term we are beginning our **History** theme in which we will explore the question:  
*How has farming changed over time?*



We will be learning about the timeline of tools and farming equipment throughout history, and looking at similarities and differences between them.

In **English** we will be studying the traditional tale "Little Red" and "Iggy Peck Architect". We will create our own version of Little Red Riding Hood and a non-fiction buildings fact file.



**Maths** this half term, we will focus on

**EYFS:** One more, one less, odd, even, doubling, combining groups, length, height, time, mass and capacity

**Y1:** Place Value to 20, addition and subtraction to 20.

**Y2:** Money, multiplication and division.

In **Science**, we will be investigating Seasonal Change



We will work scientifically to investigate what happens through the seasons in the UK in terms of the weather and how it affects nature.

In **Computing** we will be learning about Moving Robots and using the BeeBots.

In **Music** lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat and pulse through assorted songs.

In **daily PE**, we will focus on:

**EYFS:** "Seasons" in dance & Fundamental Movement Skills based on "Rosie's Walk" in games.

**Y1&2** Gymnastics and dance based on "The Three Little Pigs".

Children will also be **swimming** on a **Thursday** afternoon.

Please can hair be tied back each day.

In **DT**, we will design and make a shelter for the three little pigs.



Our **SCARF PSHE** theme this half term is all about "Valuing Differences."

In **RE** this half term our unit will be focussed on the question:

**EYFS:** Special People - Why do Christians believe Jesus is special?

**Y1&2:** What made Jesus special?

**LEAF visit:** Farming in the past vs today

**How can I help at home?**

**EYFS:** Keywords, phonics sheets & daily reading.
