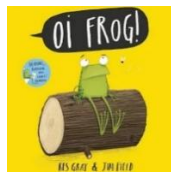
This term we are beginning our **History** theme in which we will explore the question:

Who was Mary Anning?



We will be learning about the who Mary was and why she is still important for us to think about today.

In **English** we will continue studying "The odd egg," creating a non-fiction egg spotting guide as well as looking at poetry and rhymes with the text "Oi Frog!"



Maths this half term will focus on:-

EYFS: 3D shapes, numbers to 20 and beyond, addition and subtraction plus manipulating 2D shapes.

Y1: Multiplication, division and fractions.

Y2: Fractions and time.

In **KS1 Science**, we will be investigating: Everyday Materials. We will work identify and name materials, describing their physical properties and compare them.

In the **EYFS** we will investigating the environments in which animals live.

In **Computing** we will be learning about Digital Photography, using our beautiful outdoors to capture this.

In **daily PE**, we will focus on:-

EYFS: "Jungle" in dance & Fundamental Movement Skills based on "Superworm."

Y1/2: Games based on developing kicking skills and net/wall ball skills.

Please can hair be tied back each day.

In **Music** lessons, we will be exploring musical elements of pitch, rhythm, beat and pulse in a unit based on "Exploring Improvisation."

In **Art**, we will be developing our drawing, painting, collage and 3D skills, using clay and wire, whilst studying works by Matisse, Miro and Celia Smith.

In **RE** this half term our units will be:-

EYFS: -continuing "Special people" including religious leaders of other faiths.

Y1/2: - continuing "Jesus was special" exploring more of his miracles."
